The oldest 'new' course in the world, commissioned by the Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews, the second course at the Home of Golf was built by the Keeper of the Green Tom Morris in 1895 and it was imaginatively named to differentiate from its famous neighbor. Boasting undulating fairways and challenging greens, the New Course is a classic test of Links golf. The New Course, often referred to as the local's favorite, is tighter and the dense gorse and swathes present a prettier golf course. If located anywhere else, away from the looming shadow of the iconic Old Course, this golf course would certainly hold a higher reputation.

Many of the University of St Andrews Golf Team matches are played over the New Course. It would be a real disappointment to visit St Andrews and not play the New.
